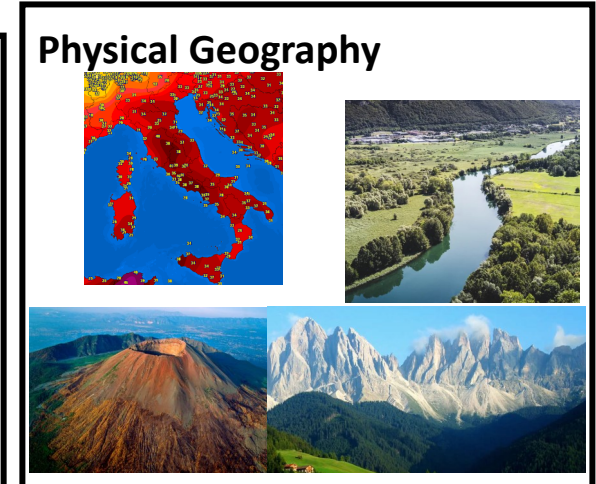


Where in the world is Italy? - Knowledge Organiser - Year 3 Spring

Key Vocab	Definition
Peninsular	A piece of land that juts out from the mainland and is mostly surrounded by water,
Regions	Italy has regions like the UK has counties. Areas of land within in Italy.
Alps	The Alps are a large stem of mountains that run through Europe.
Mediterranean Climate	This is when a country has mild winters and warm to hot summers, with little rain.
Volcano	A mountain or hill with a crater or vent that lava or hot vapor from the earths crust can come through.
Landmark	An object or feature that is easily seen and recognized.
Culture	This is made up of the beliefs and traditions of the people who live in the country.
Island	A piece of land that is completely surrounded by water,
Peak	The pointed top of a mountain.
