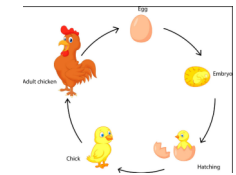

bake	To cook food in dry heat, normally in an oven.
Spring	The season after Winter, where new signs of life appear (animals and flowers).
