Vocabulary	Definition
------------	------------

City	A city is larger than a town, Nottingham has a population of 800,000
Physical feature	Natural features such as rivers or hills
Human feature	Man made features such as roads, schools or hospitals
City centre	The centre of the city, often the main shopping or business area.
Map	A 2D drawing showing physical or human features
Compass points	There are 4 main compass points North, East, South, West
Tram	A passenger vehicle running on rails along a road
