Lockdown Memories Game

Print out the board and rainbows on A3 paper. Cut out the rainbows and place in a pile.

Each player to have a coloured counter. Each person in turn throws a die and moves that number of places.

Which ever word they land on they need to answer the question. So for example if you land on sad then the question would be 'What was a sad memory during lockdown?' Another one might be 'What was a kind memory during lockdown? If they answer the question they collect a rainbow card.

The game ends when everyone has reached the finish. The winner is the person who collected the most rainbow cards.
