Sunlight

- The light from the sun can be dangerous.
- It can damage our eyes.

Reflecting light

Shiny surfaces reflect light well.







Matt surfaces don't reflect light well.

Why do we need light?

- We need light to see things.
 - If it's completely dark, there's no light.
- The more light there is, the easier it is to see objects.

Shadows



Shadows are formed when an opaque object blocks the light.

The child is blocking the sun's light.

We can change the size of the shadow by changing the position of the:

- light source
- surface where the shadow is being made.
