Please note that jewellery is **not** permitted in PE lessons for safety reasons. If your child cannot take their own earrings out, please make sure they have been removed before school. Children with long hair should wear it up during PE lessons so please ensure they have a bobble.

### Reading – Our class text will be: The Firework Maker's Daughter

In Year 4, we expect the children to <u>read 3 or more times a week at home</u> and should be recorded in their organisers. While listening to them read, you could also ask questions about something they may have seen or heard to improve their comprehension skills. e.g. asking them to predict what might happen next (and why), asking about a character's feelings and actions, or getting them to summarise what they have just read.

New reading diaries are for the whole school year, so children should get into the habit keeping them in their bags, so that they know where they are and to school daily.

Each half term we work towards a reading reward. Children need to aim for at least 3 signatures per week, which will contribute to a whole class total. We're working towards a total of 1,000 reads per class to earn a special reading treat.

#### **Spellings**

Children will receive a set of spellings each week, which will be stuck into their organisers every Friday and also uploaded onto Class Dojo. It's important that children bring their organisers to school daily so they can access their spelling lists during practice sessions.

Some children may be given a reduced number of spellings tailored to the week's spelling rule.

These will be highlighted in yellow and will be the only words they are tested on.

Spelling tests will take place every Friday. Additionally, at the end of each half term, children will be assessed on approximately 15 words linked to the spelling rules covered during that period. If your child learns their spellings quickly, please encourage them to practise using the words in full sentences to deepen their understanding.

### Times Tables- How can I support my child in maths?

Under the current National Curriculum, children are expected to know all of their times tables by the end of Year 4 (up to 12x12). The government have introduced a multiplication table check (MTC) for children in Year 4, which takes place in June 2026. The times table check relies on children being able to recall times table facts in 6 seconds, with a 3 second rest before the next question. Please support your child to help them learn their multiplication tables at home. To support this, all children in Year 4 have a Times Table Rockstars login – using TTRS helps track their progress and determine where more support and practise is required. Although the questions are generated randomly, questions about the 6, 7, 8, 9, and 12 times table come up more often, so the speed of recall in these times tables is vital.

### Doodle Maths

Your child will already have been using this learning platform and we would like the children to continue with this throughout Year 4 - It has been proven that little and often will support the children's with learning and remembering. Logins have changed so new ones are stuck in the organisers. (If your child lost their streak when they were changed please let us know.)
