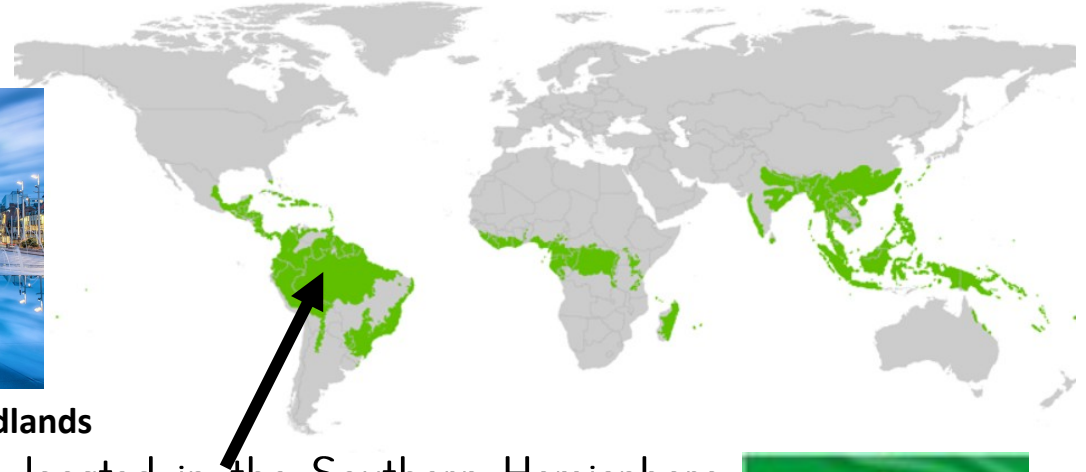


# What is it like to live in Brazil?

Climate	The <b>weather</b> conditions over a long period of time.
Equator	An imaginary circle running around the centre of the earth.
Humid	Feeling very damp due to water vapor in the air
Native tribes	The original settlers of an area.
Weather	The specific conditions on a given day.
Deforestation	Cutting down many trees which is bad for the environment.
Population	The number of people living in a certain place.
Tropical	Very hot and wet. Tropical climates are located around the equator.
